“This gift by which God leans to us and lifts us up ... For in grace you see a light that covers all the world in love, and watch fear disappear from every face as hearts rise up and claim the light as theirs.” — A Course in Miracles, LESSON 168

Genade is wat die Grieks noem, χάρις (garis) en die Hebreeus גָּנִים (gein)
— liefdevolle goedheid, sagmoedigheid, liefdevolle welwillendheid,
goedertierenheid, liefdevolle guns, wat die liefde van God ontsluit
(that which enables the power of God, or precious love of God)

1. GENADE SÊ: “LEARN TO RECEIVE GRACEFULLY” — genade kan net vloei as ons **OOP** is om die liefdevolle goedheid van God te sien. Ons kan net gee as ons geleer het om te ontvang ... genade is die liefde vir die liefdelose wie se hart oop is om (oorvloed) te ontvang — **The GRACE of CONSCIOUSNESS**

2. GENADE IS OM GOD SE LIEFDE TE (H)ER(KEN) — harte wat oop is, maak sintuie bewus van dit wat vreugde bring, en ervaar ons ‘the holy influence of splendour, desire, delight upon our souls’ — **The GRACE of AWARENESS**

3. GENADE MOET INLOOP EN OORLOOP — genade móét vloei, dit kan nie stilstaan of afgekamp word nie ... daarom die herinnering: *giving transforms having into being ... and being into becoming* — **The GRACE of PRESENCE**

4. GENADE SKUIF DIE 'ek/my' NA 'ons' — genade is vir ALMAL, ALTYD as ons hoor: “doen aan ander” en “jou naaste soos jouself” ... dit raak al die aspekte van ons lewe (a way of life) — die sleutel is vergiffenis want ons kan net ‘genade’ as ons vry en wakker is — **The GRACE of AWAKENING**

5. GENADE IS DIE KRAG IN SWAKHEID — dit help ons om *anders* te dink, *anders* op te tree, *anders* te reageer. Waar ons die gevolg (effek) verander, verander (vernuwe) ons ervaring met Lewe, Lig, en Liefde en leer seer ons meer as lag ... dis 'n deurleefde transformasie — **The GRACE of REBIRTH**
